the shops

Take your litter home

Have a re-usable lunch box rather than
plastic bags

Grow your own vegetables or herbs

Buy second-hand stuff

Use re-chargable batteries

Take a shower rather than a bath

Turn off your devices when you're not
using them

Re-use a jam jar as a candle holder

Get on your bike, not in your car

Donate clothes you no longer want to
charity shops

Buy locally sourced food

Turn the tap off while you brush your
teeth

Eat less meat – go vegetarian at least
one meal a week

Buy products made from
recycled materials

Use paper straws instead of plastic ones

Park and stride instead of riding
all the way

Turn off the lights when you
leave the room
