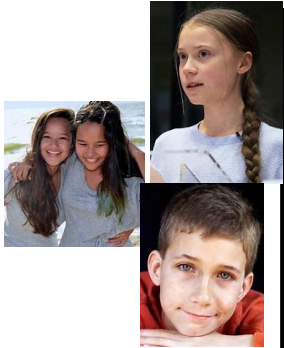

Anna wasn't afraid to tell others about God

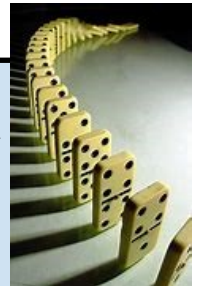


Naaman had faith (believed) that God could heal him
