



Prayer Diary November 2025

“With thankful hearts offer up your prayers and requests to God”

Philippians 4:6 [CEV]

Sat 1 st	Thank God for the recent testimony of those who have grown in their relationship with Him through the discipline of daily Bible Reading and prayer.
Sun 2 nd	Pray that God will give us patience as we continue to seek the Lord’s leading regarding a new minister and pray that we can learn what He wants to teach us through this experience. Pray that God will strengthen us and embolden us to reach out and find new ways of sharing His love and being salt and light to the community around us.
Mon 3 rd	Pray for the Nepali Church aid organisation which is seeking to provide relief to areas devastated by a severe end to the monsoon. In the far eastern Koshi district as many as 25,000 people were displaced by floods. Pray for the safety of the workers.
Tue 4 th	Give thanks for the deacons who continue to have a greater than usual workload because of our interregnum situation. Pray for daily strength and wisdom, and that they will experience joy in their service. Pray that there will be others willing to let their names stand in the deacons’ election later this month.
Wed 5 th	Let us pray for those who have recently had surgery and who are recovering at home or in hospital. Pray that their recovery will go well and that they will know God’s love and care in a special way.
Thu 6 th	Pray for the Women’s Fellowship meeting this afternoon. Give thanks for the close bonds that have built up between the members over many years and pray that they can continue to bless and encourage each other.
Fri 7 th	Give thanks for those who have been attending the Alpha course each Friday evening and pray that they will be led to consider what God is teaching them through the lessons. Pray that some will come to come to faith in Christ before the sessions end.
Sat 8 th	Pray for the team hosting Saturday Kitchen this morning and for the families who will come. Pray that relationships can be built up that will lead to families feeling loved and supported. Give thanks for the volunteers who give up their time to provide this valuable opportunity to serve families in our community and pray that those who attend will enjoy the food and space to meet and play.
Sun 9 th	Pray for those leading the service this morning and for those involved in any way, including those helping behind the scenes. Pray that we will be able to worship from our hearts, especially as we share communion together.
Mon 10 th	Give thanks for the new team leading the Coffee, Cake and Company sessions and for the opportunity they afford for those feeling isolated and downhearted to receive support and encouragement. Give thanks, too, for contacts with people who pop in before or after attending other events in the building. Pray that there will be opportunities to share God’s love and His message.
Tue 11 th	Praise God for what He is doing in the lives of those isolated in the leprosarium’s of Odisha in India through the efforts of The Leprosy Mission and its supporters, including BRBC.
Wed 12 th	Give thanks for the many different opportunities there are for people to meet together to pray: - prayer gatherings at church, house groups, prayer triplets, listen and pray etc. and pray that we will all be able to be involved in the prayer ministry in some way. Pray for the Zoom Prayer gathering planned for this evening to go well.
Thu 13 th	Pray for the team preparing for lunch club today and for those who will come to enjoy the meal. Pray that they will be blessed and encouraged by the conversations that will go on around the tables and by the message that will be given afterwards. Pray, too, for Craft Club that will follow.
Fri 14 th	Give thanks for Horsham Matters and for the Food Banks that help struggling families. Pray that there will be enough donations to help those most in need.
Sat 15 th	Pray for Claire Bedford as she returns to Chad after annual leave with her family in UK. Give thanks for a new member of the pharmacy staff and for the large government donation of mosquito nets to give to families to protect them from malaria. Pray for US citizens who have had to leave Chad because of reciprocal visa restrictions.

Sun 16 th	Give thanks for the BRBK team who keep the Sunday morning sessions going week by week. Pray that a good number of families will attend regularly so that the children can benefit from consistent Bible teaching.
Mon 17 th	Give thanks for all those who help to keep PMA going and pray that it will continue to bring blessing and encouragement to those who regularly attend. Pray for the meeting this afternoon when Wendy from The Leprosy Mission will be sharing about the organisation's work.
Tue 18 th	Pray for our young people who are away at college or university. Pray that they will be able to make Christian friends and find churches to attend where they will be warmly welcomed.
Wed 19 th	Give thanks for the training that Peter and Louise Lynch were able to give to young people in one area where there are 28 churches and only 7 trained pastors. Some of the young folk are now able to lead worship and share teaching from God's word. Pray for safety as the Lynches need to travel long distances to fulfil their ministry.
Thu 20 th	Praise God for the pastoral team who visit those who are in hospital, those not well at home, those in care homes and others not able to get out to church these days, and who also take people to medical appointments, provide meals for those in need etc. etc. Pray that God will give them the strength that they need and encourage them in their ministry, which is greatly appreciated.
Fri 21 st	Give thanks that Cally, leader of the Eagle Project, is now settled in a new home in a quieter neighbourhood of Sao Paulo and that she has already been able to reach out to neighbours. Pray that the application for government funding to enable a project to train former prisoners as barbers to go ahead will be successful. Pray for son, Ben, starting yet another job.
Sat 22 nd	Give thanks for Horsham Churches Together and for those who are involved in planning events. Praise God for the good relationships that there are between the various churches in our town and pray that our combined witness will result in others attending church. Pray for those planning the Christmas event in the Carfax on December 6 th .
Sun 23 rd	Give thanks for the young people who meet week by week on a Sunday afternoon and for those who host them, make friends with them and seek to demonstrate Christian living to them. Pray that lasting relationships can be built up that will provide on-going support and encouragement.
Mon 24 th	Give thanks for the good harvest experienced in Northern Uganda where Genesis has been helping farmers to improve their yields and pray that his new initiative to encourage farmers to mill some of their grain and sell it as flour will go well.
Tue 25 th	Give thanks that so many organisations are able to use our facilities for a wide variety of activities and for the good relations that have been built up with those who help in various ways in the building during the week. Pray that some may be led to want to learn more about the Christian message that the church stands for.
Wed 26 th	Pray for the Church Meeting this evening. Pray especially as the election of deacons will take place. Pray that God will overrule in any decisions that are made.
Thu 27 th	Let us pray especially today for Michael Hogg as he continues to take on a large number of responsibilities outside his original remit. Pray for continued strength and wisdom as our interregnum period has stretched out longer than we had hoped.
Fri 28 th	Give thanks for all those who help behind the scenes to keep things going at church in such a good way:- those who help with maintenance, those who keep the building clean, those who act as receptionists during the week, etc. etc. Give thanks for Karry and pray for wisdom and energy for her in her administrative role.
Sat 29 th	Pray for those preparing the various special Christmas events and pray that the events will provide opportunities for a good number of people to come and hear the Christmas message.
Sun 30 th	Pray that a good number will be able to attend the Advent Breakfast this morning and that it will be an opportunity for us all to build closer relationships with each other. Pray that newcomers will feel especially welcome. Pray, too, for the special Advent Service this morning.
